## DOLLY PARTON'S IMAGINATION LIBRARY

Learning math, science, technology, history – mastering all of these subjects requires kids to have strong reading skills.

**United Way of Southwest Wyoming** partners with the **Dolly Parton's Imagination Library** to give every child in Fremont, Lincoln, Sweetwater and Uinta Counties access to free books. Kids who enroll in the program receive a new book in the mail every month from birth to five years old. All for free!
